Three APAEM initiated projects received highly-competitive external research grants.

Prof. Priscilla Tam's research on "Tourism Cooperation in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Greater Bay Area" has obtained a research grant from the Education Fund of the Macao SAR Government.

Prof. Yibai Yang's study on "Effects of R&D Policy on Technology, Economic Growth and Social Welfare" and Prof. Jet Shu's project on "High-Dimensional Financial Index Tracking based on the Regularization Approach" received research grants from the Department of Science and Technology of Guangdong.

In August, APAEM co-funded project "Platform for Financial Computing Acceleration – Building the Application Ecosystem for Chip Industry" won the championship of the Macao Youth Innovation and Entrepreneurship Competition 2022, showing the high quality and recognition of APAEM's industry-academia collaboration.

Besides, Prof. Rob Law won an award for Outstanding Reviewer in the 2022 Emerald Literati Awards. He was nominated by the editorial team of International Journal of Contemporary Hospitality Management (SSCI, Q1), an international reputable journal in tourism and hospitality with impact factor of 9.321 in 2021. This recognition signifies the contribution of APAEM scholar to the academic society.
